

Disqualified Sites Hwy 9 and 236

1. Boulder Creek Community Church at 12465 Hwy 9 – This is a very low structure, similar to a one story residential building. An installation here would have required a tower. Directly adjacent to the Church are residentially owned parcels. The tower would be within 100' of these parcels therefore the candidate was disqualified.
2. United Methodist Church at 12855 Boulder Street - There was not sufficient ground space on the outside of the building in order to place the radio equipment. Would require at least a 12'x16' area. There was also insufficient space within the building for the equipment therefore the candidate was disqualified.
3. I.O.O.F. Building at 13101 Hwy 9 – This building is the tallest in the downtown area of Boulder Creek but it is a historical landmark. Any installation here would require a change in its appearance therefore it was disqualified.
4. Burl Business Center at 13200 Hwy 9 – This building and the ones adjacent to it are slightly taller than others in the area but are very old and structurally inadequate.
5. New Leaf Market at 13159 Hwy 9 – This is the organic market. Although it is fairly tall there is no space on the exterior of the building for Verizon Wireless to put its radio equipment without using up 3 or 4 parking spaces. The owners were not approached as it did not seem likely that they would be amenable given the nature of their business and their clientele.
